# ***'Shivalaya'*** **inaugurated** **@ Chitrakoot**

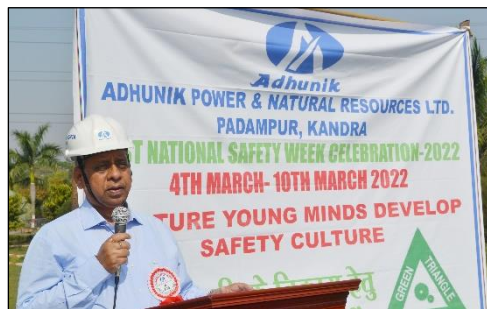
In Chitrakoot apartment, the residential colony of Adhunik Power & Natural Resources Limited, a new Shiv temple inaugurated inside the premises.
