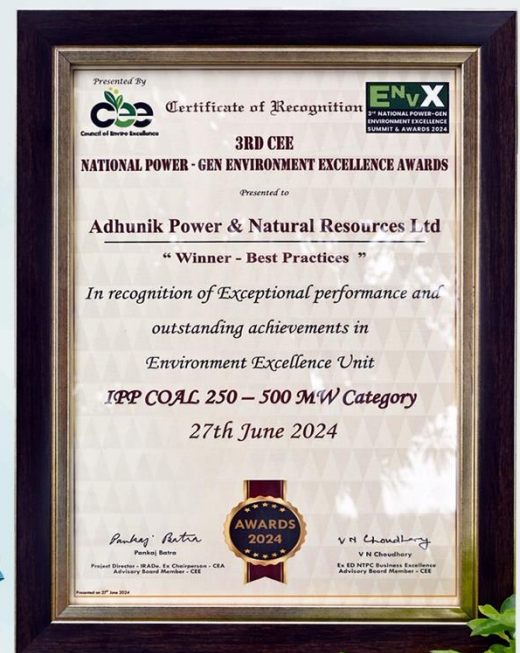

The primary objective of this initiative is to train villagers to develop kitchen gardens, enabling them to grow and consume green vegetables year-round. This practice not only

helps families stay healthy but also fosters self-sufficiency.

The training was conducted by Dr. Anjali Mishra, Senior Scientist at KVK, Saraikela-Kharsawan, who explained the concept and process of kitchen gardening in detail. The program saw active participation from 50 women hailing from villages such as Badahari-

harpur, Chhotahariharpur, Bikanipur and Padampur. At the conclusion of the session, seasonal vegetable seeds were distributed to all participants.

She emphasized that, this training should translate into tangible results, with each participant establishing their own kitchen garden.
