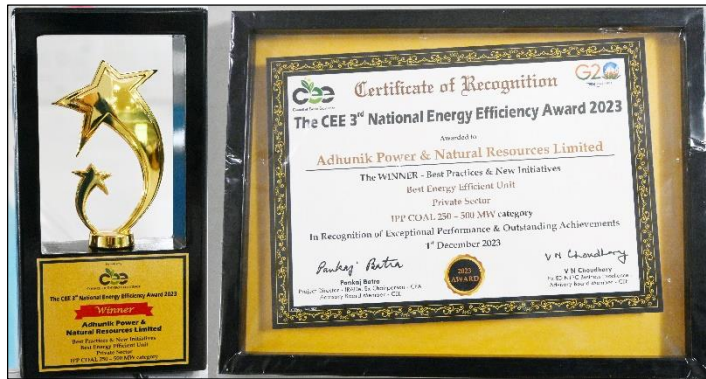
# Crowned up with best energy efficient unit award
