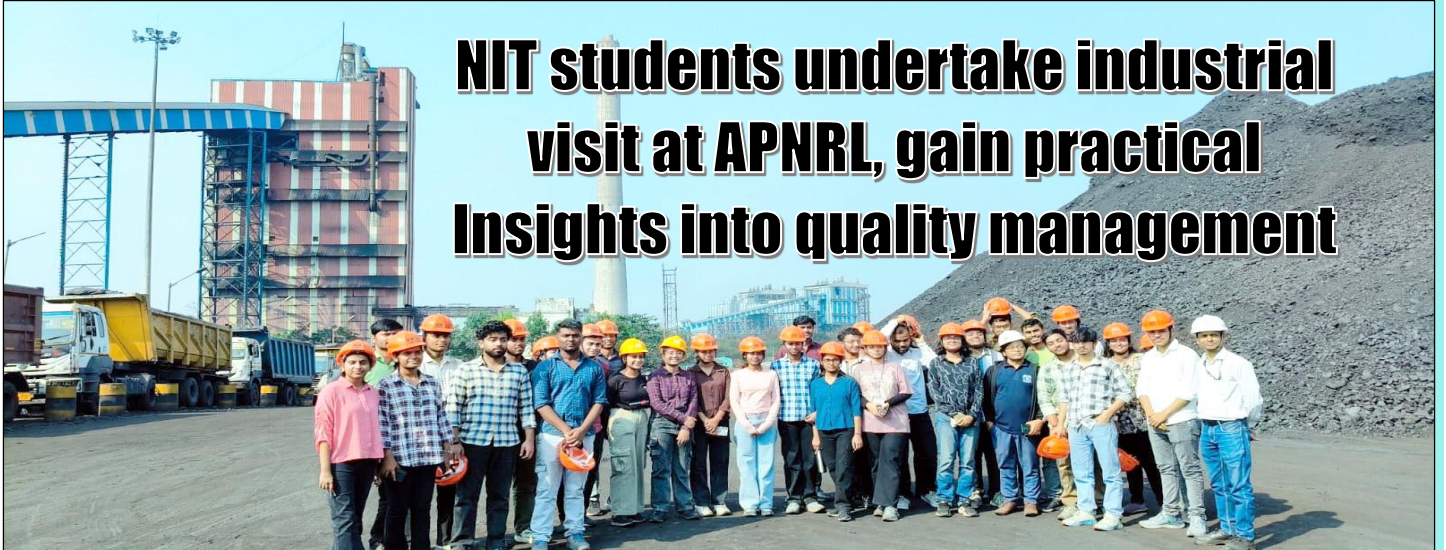

## NIT students undertake industrial visit at APNRL, gain practical Insights into quality management

In a significant initiative aimed at bridging the gap between technical education and industrial exposure, students of the Quality Club from the National Institute of Technology (NIT) Jamshedpur undertook an educational visit to Adhunik Power & Natural Resources Limited.

Officials of the APNRL warmly welcomed the students and briefed them on the plant's stringent safety standards and operational protocols. The visiting group was then taken on a guided tour of key operational facilities including the Coal Handling Plant, Boiler Unit, Turbine Section and the Central Control Room. During the

visit, plant engineers provided detailed explanations of the entire power generation process, from coal combustion and steam generation to turbine operation and electricity production. The students were also introduced to various aspects of quality control, real-time monitoring systems, preventive maintenance practices and environmental management measures implemented at the plant. Particular emphasis was laid on the plant's emission control systems and sustainability initiatives, which left a strong impression on the visiting students.

# Swarnarekha clinches MPL-7 title

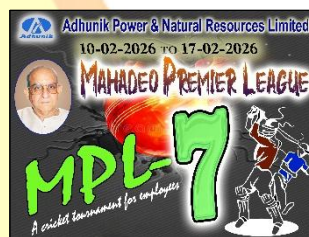
**Sushil Tudu adjudged MoS, Rakesh Mahato best batter while Manik Sardar declared best bowler**



The seventh edition of the Mahadev Premier League (MPL) Tennis Ball Cricket Tournament, organized by Adhunik Power & Natural Resources Limited for its employees, concluded on a high note with Team Swarnarekha emerged as champions.
