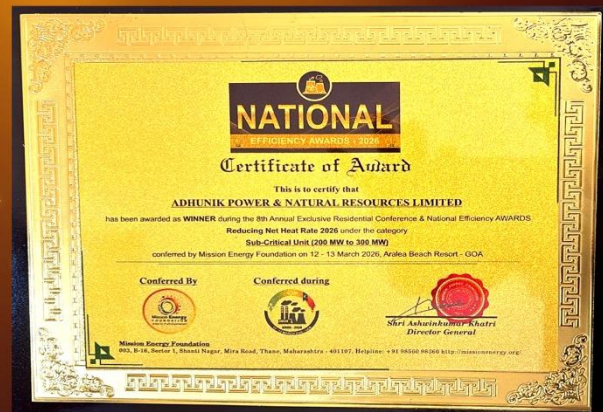


APNRL winner again

Interactive sessions with plant specialists provided students an opportunity to clarify technical queries related to high-pressure systems and grid synchronization.
