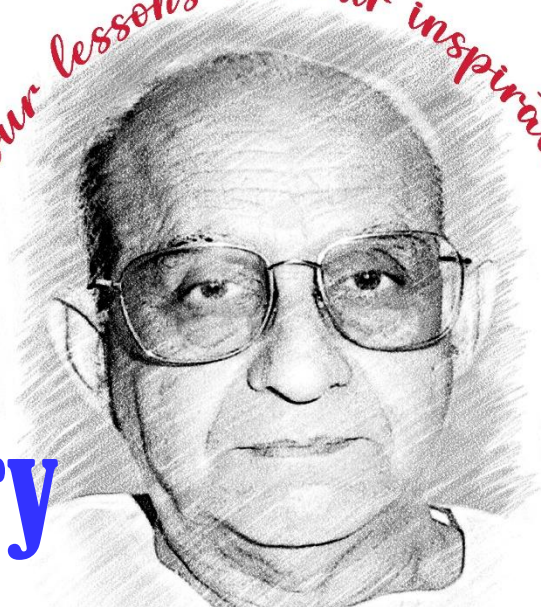
The prestigious award was presented by Mr. Pankaj Batra, Project
