War against tuberculosis continue

Adhunik Power & Natural Resources Limited distributed food baskets to 50 tuberculosis (TB) patients in the Gamharia block as part of the National TB Eradication Program to continue its war against TB. This initiative was carried out in association with Nikshay Mitra at the Community Health Center (CHC) in Gamharia. The food baskets included essential items such as moong pulse, jaggery, chana, arhar pulse, soyabean, oat meal, groundnut oil and chura. The event was attended by several distinguished guests, including Dr. C.B. Chaudhary, District TB Officer, Dr. Laxmi Kumari, Medical Officer in Charge, Nirmal Das, District Program Manager (Health), Mr. Potel Hansda, STS (TB Program) and representatives from APNRL, including Mr. Rajesh Kumar Sharma (VP-Finance Head), Mr. Anil Sardar, Ravi Shankar Singh, and Vikas Kumar. Dr. C.B. Chaudhary emphasized the importance of completing TB treatment, as many patients in rural areas tend to discontinue their medication due to negligence. He noted



that incomplete treatment allows the TB virus to persist, posing a risk of transmission to others. He stressed that patients must take their medication regularly and pay close attention to their diet to enhance their ability to overcome the infection.

Mr. Rajesh Kumar Sharma added that prevention of this disease is possible and that effective and ac-

cessible treatment is available, with the government offering free resources for both prevention and treatment. He expressed the company's commitment to supporting the patients by providing nutritious food each month to promote healthier eating habits.
