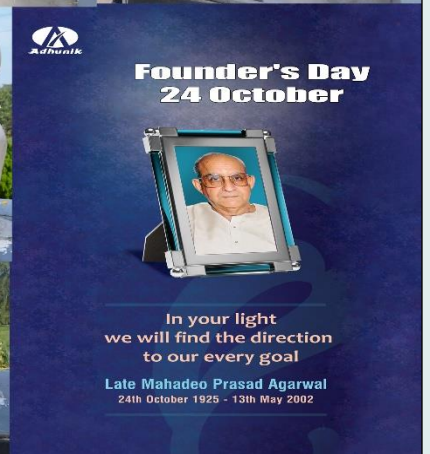
No development can imagine without Women Empowerment
