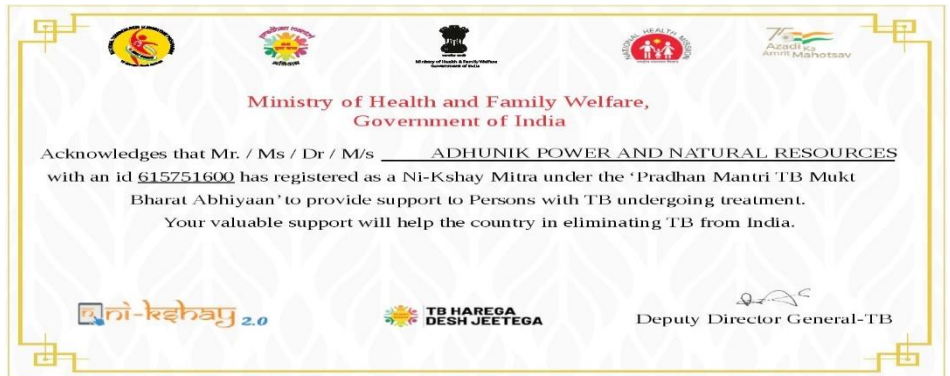
CSR activities

Eye care awareness cum check-up camp for truck drivers

conducted eye check-up test specially for drivers at plant. Members of Purnima Netralaya comprising Mr. Rajnikant Mahato, Md. Shahabuddin, Ms. Shaili Mehkud and Ms. Radhika performed eye tests and awareness counselling.

A total of 77 persons (55 truck drivers and 22 APNRL employees) were benefited as truck drivers were specially invited for the camp so that they should know and be aware of their eye care.
