More 'SHAKTI' to Power



THE Adhunik Power & Natural Resources Limited (APNRL) has achieved yet another milestone by signing two agreements in form of amendment-2 & 3 under SHAKTI (Scheme for Harnessing and Allocating Koyala Transparently in India) scheme.

This will give more strength to APNRL. Shri Sachin Kumar Agarwal, Vice-President (Corporate Affairs) along with Mr. Arun Kumar, GM (Liaison) and Mr. Eshan Singh, Deputy Manager (Power Trading) signed the agreement with Jharkhand State DISCOM- Jharkhand Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited (JBVNL) representatives Mr. Arvind Kumar, Executive Director- Commercial & Revenue, Mr. Rishi Nandan, GM (Commercial) and Ms. Anita Prasad, DGM (Tariff). As per signed amendments, 2 & 3 to the PPA dated 22.09.2012, now APNRL shall receive Linkage for 54575.5 Tonnes and 51378.15 Tonnes of Coal under SHAKTI SCHEME and will be providing 08 Paisa and 10 paisa discounts to State DISCOM.

It may be mentioned that this Coal Linkage will be beneficial in providing a stable coal supply to APNRL. Notably, SHAKTI (Scheme for Harnessing and Allocating Koyala Transparently in India) is a policy designated by the Union Government for the allocation of coal among thermal power plants in a transparent and objective manner.
